**Florida's Reptiles and Amphibians: K-3**

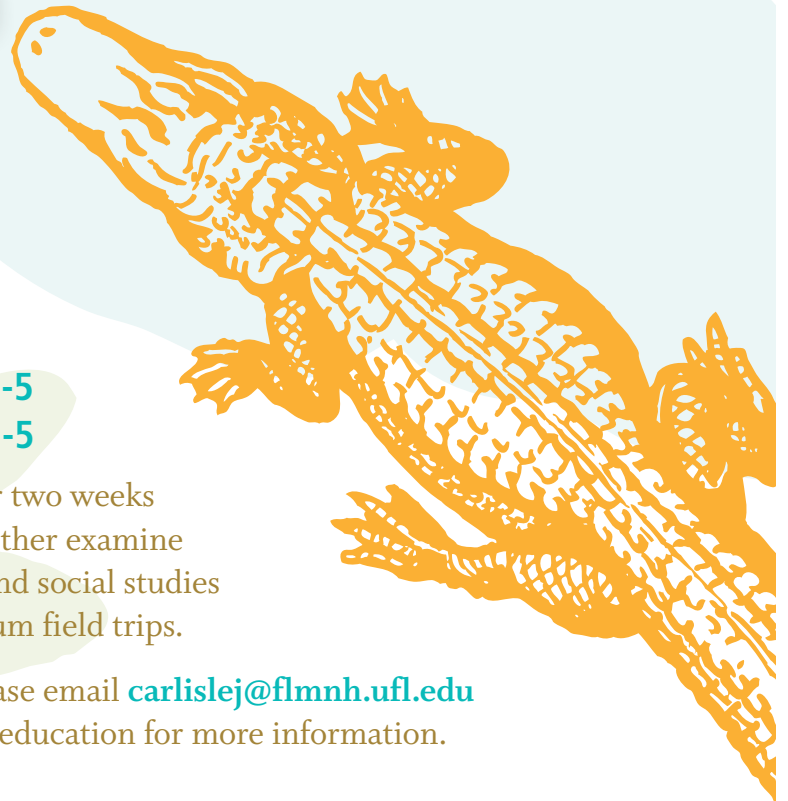
**Florida's Seminole People: K-5**
